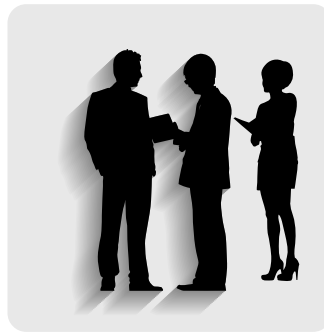

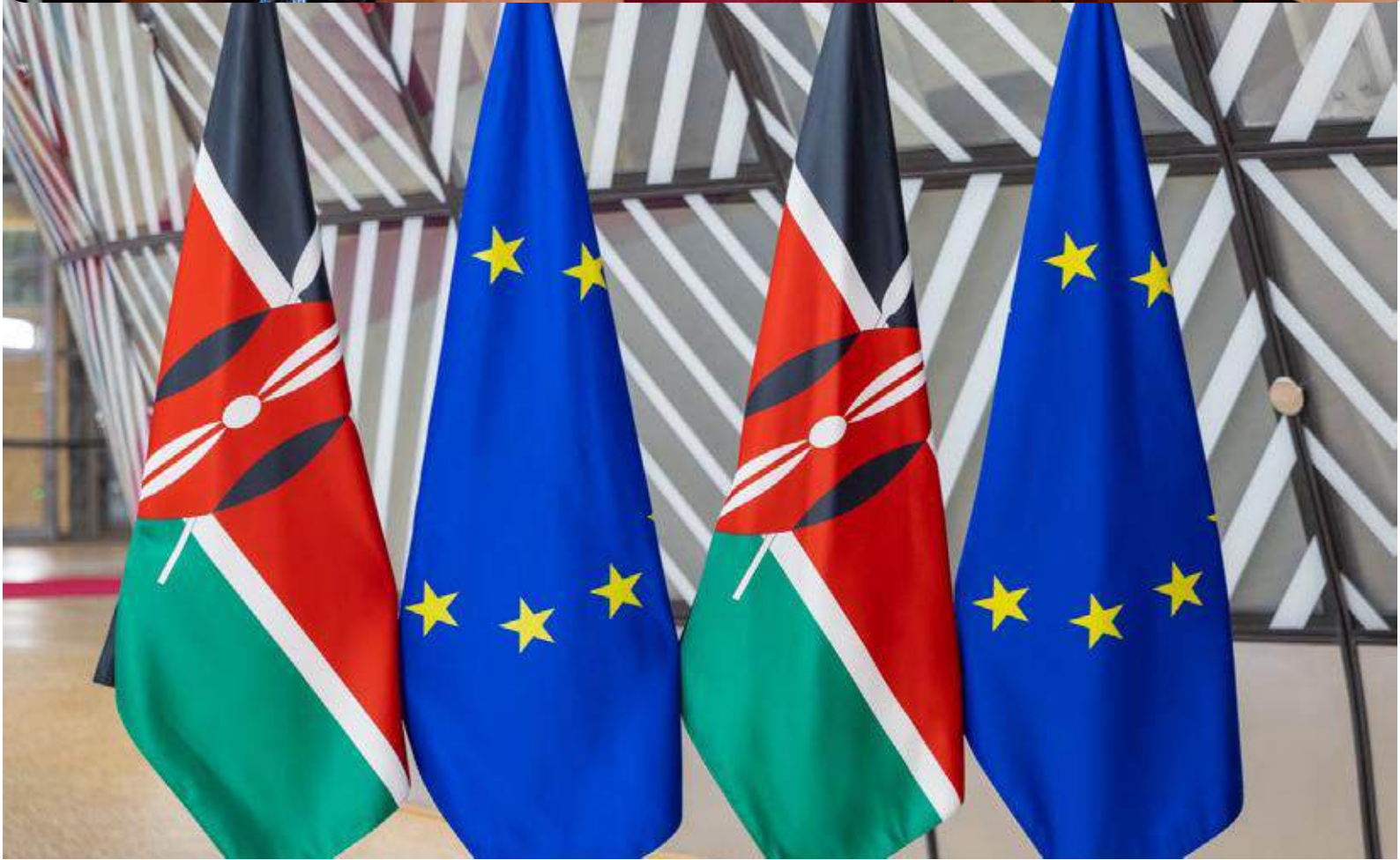


ENGAGING COUNTY GOVERNMENTS ON TRADE LICENSING FOR PROFESSIONALS

A consultative meeting was held with the Director of Committees and Programs together with Technical Leads in Trade at the Council of Governors (CoG) to deliberate on trade licensing for professionals across counties. Discussions focused on promoting regulatory coherence, streamlining licensing processes, and creating a more enabling environment for professional practice. The engagement opened up discussions to strengthen collaboration with county governments in advancing efficient, transparent, and harmonized licensing frameworks.

STRENGTHENING KENYA–EU ECONOMIC PARTNERSHIP DIALOGUE

Participation in the establishment and selection process of the Chairperson of the Domestic Advisory Group (DAG) under the Kenya–European Union Economic Partnership Agreement (EPA) highlighted the importance of inclusive stakeholder engagement in international trade matters. The process contributes to strengthening governance structures and promoting effective dialogue in the implementation of the agreement.



CONTRIBUTING TO KENYA'S INTEGRITY AGENDA

The Kenya Leadership Integrity Forum (KLIF), under the Ethics and Anti-Corruption Commission (EACC), convened a high-level workshop in Naivasha to review progress in implementing the Kenya Integrity Plan (2023–2028). The forum brought together public and private sector stakeholders to assess achievements, identify gaps, and align efforts towards strengthening transparency, accountability, and ethical leadership.





ADVANCING DATA PROTECTION AND DIGITAL GOVERNANCE

Professional perspectives were represented during a stakeholder consultation convened by the Office of the Data Protection Commissioner (ODPC) on the Draft Guidance for the Transport Sector and Cross-Border Data Transfers. Contributions focused on privacy, regulatory compliance, responsible data management, and the development of practical frameworks that support Kenya's growing digital economy.

7TH ENGINEERING PARTNERSHIPS CONVENTION 2026

Participation in the convention held in Mombasa provided an opportunity to engage with engineering professionals, institutions, and development partners. The event facilitated networking, knowledge exchange, and exploration of collaborative opportunities while showcasing initiatives that support professional growth and institutional development.



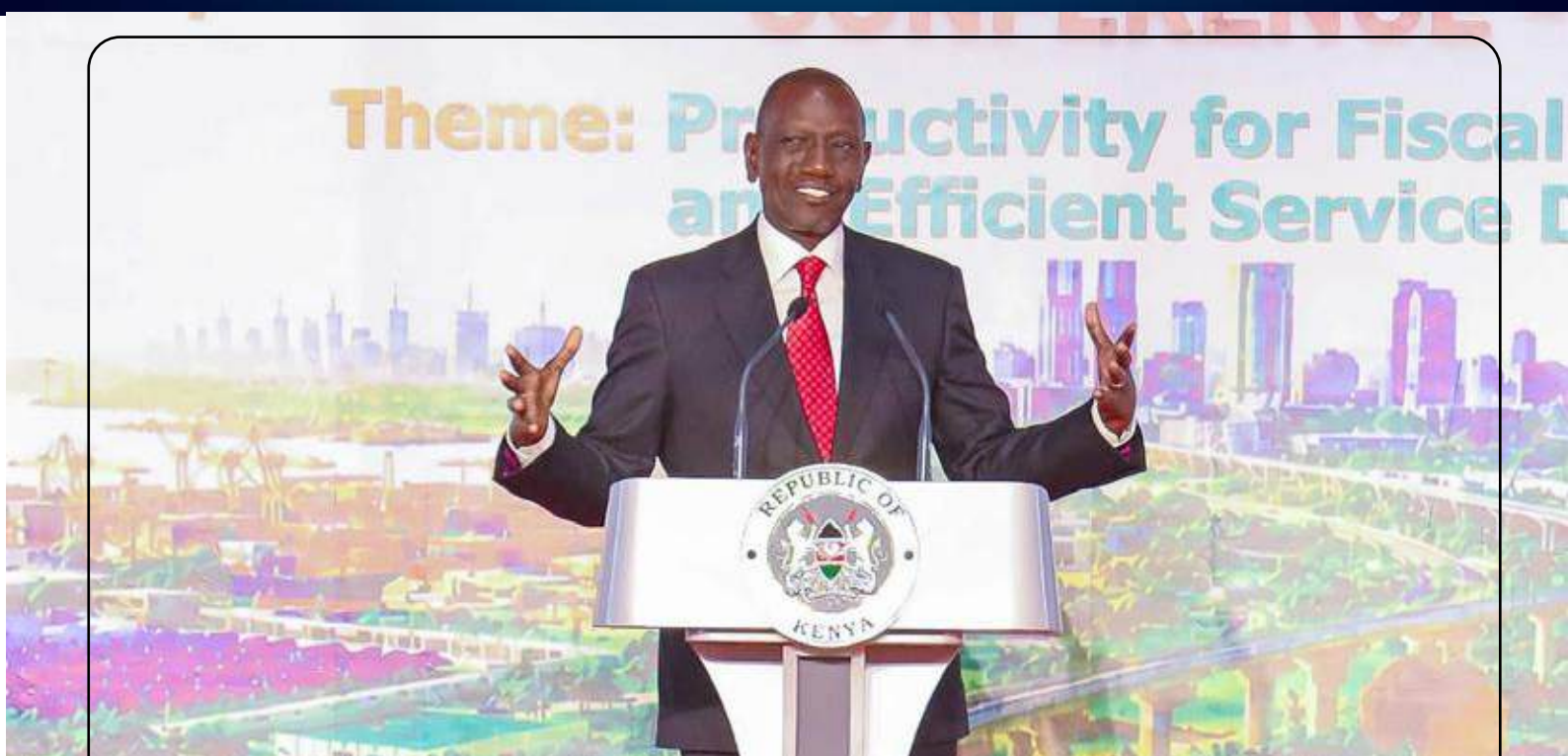
1ST NATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS CONFERENCE 2026

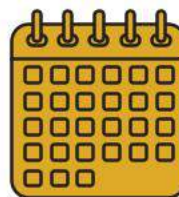
