Kenya Professionals Development Fund was established by **APSEA** as an Endowment Fund with the support of professional-conscious partners whose main mandate was to develop capacity of various professions in East Africa. The Fund started off initially as "**Kenya National Scholarship Fund**" for Professional Education in 1965.

FUND MEMBERSHIP

The members of **KPDF** are drawn from the **APSEA** membership, its Founder. **APSEA** is the apex umbrella body (Association) that brings together professional bodies of diverse disciplines. Its members are body corporate associations that have been registered in Kenya whose members are recognized professionals in their areas of training and practice, having been duly licensed and regulated by a competent regulatory authority. Accordingly, the Fund's beneficiaries shall be drawn from **APSEA** Corporate members.

MANDATE

The Mandate of the Kenya Professionals Development Fund (**KPDF**) is to promote the development of professionals and professionalism in Kenya and the East Africa region.

KPDF is headquartered at the landmark building, The Professional Centre, situated on Parliament Road in the Central Business District of Nairobi, Kenya.
